LOOK WHAT YOU ACHIEVED IN 2018:



- 🐾 **Sustained No Kill Charleston for the sixth year!** Charleston Animal Society built the first No Kill Community in the Southeast in 2013.
- 🐾 **Earned top-rated nonprofit in the state six years in a row.** Number one out of 22,000 in South Carolina.
- 🐾 **Since the formation of our No Kill South Carolina initiative, funded by Petco Foundation, almost 20,000 more lives have been saved.** Organized the first statewide adoption event that resulted in 1,188 lives saved.
- 🐾 **Led South Carolina's disaster response for animals during Hurricane Florence.** We also responded to hurricanes in North Carolina and Florida.
- 🐾 **Launched Charleston County's first rural veterinary outreach program: Helping Hands for Rural Paws.** The Charleston Animal Society model is now being replicated in Kentucky and Oklahoma. Funded by WaterShed Animal Fund, Helping Hands for Rural Paws deploys the Simon Greer Mobile Spay-Neuter Clinic to rural communities across Charleston County.
