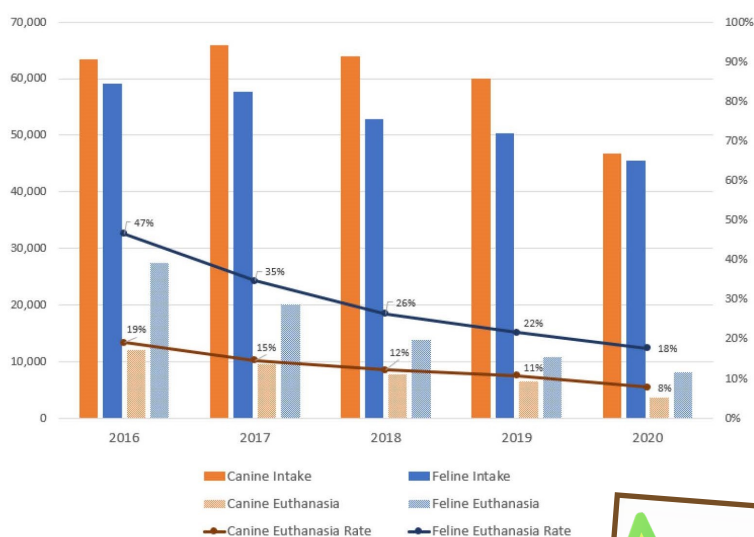


Lifesaving Strategy

No Kill South Carolina is increasing lives saved by helping communities implement leading practices of modern animal sheltering, such as:

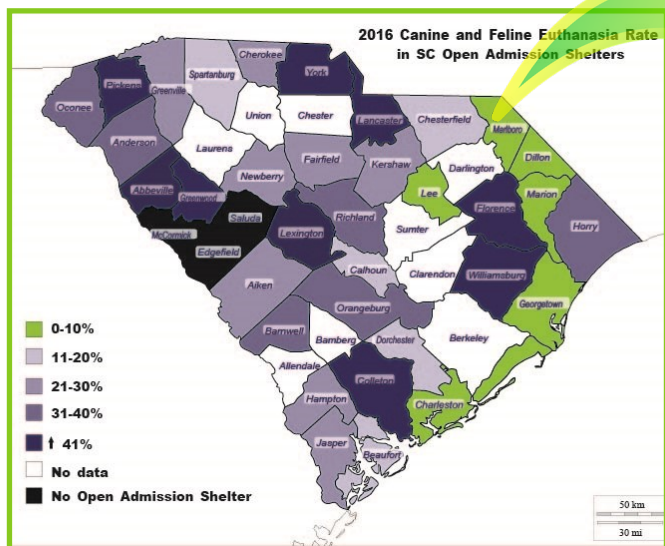
- Managed intake based on capacity for care (i.e. Humane Society of Greenwood, Humane Society of North Myrtle Beach)

Intake & Euthanasia in South Carolina Open-Admission Shelters

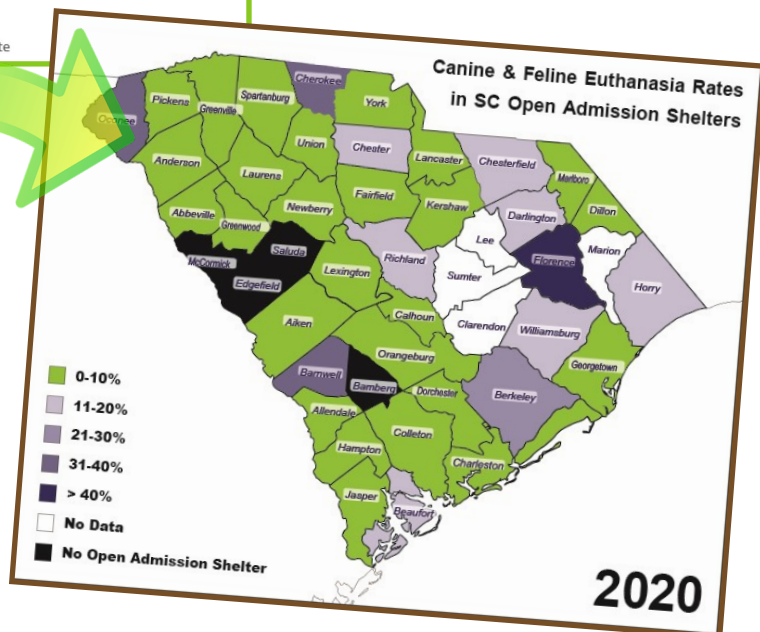
