## REDUCING OVERPOPULATION

### SPAYING / NEUTERING

Prevented countless litters by spaying or neutering **6,657** dogs and cats.

### SHELTER MEDICINE

Provided veterinary care to **5,995** shelter animals through our animal hospital.

### DISEASE PREVENTION

Administered **18,174** vaccinations preventing deadly diseases like rabies.

### COMMUNITY CAT PROGRAM

Prevented homeless kittens by Trap/Neuter/Vaccinate/Return (TNVR) of **592** free-roaming cats.

## ELIMINATING EUTHANASIA

### PET ADOPTIONS

Placed **4,248** animals into loving homes.

### LOST & FOUND

Provided **3,974** hours of casework for families and reunited **664** lost animals.

### FOSTER HOMES

Cared for **1,759** most vulnerable animals through volunteer foster homes.

### DISASTER RESPONSE

Rescued **152** animals from harm's way through **51** emergency rescue operations.

## FIGHTING CRUELTY

### ADVOCACY & INVESTIGATIONS

Partnered with law enforcement to conduct **292** cruelty investigations.

### COMMUNITY MEDICINE

Provided **1,620** families with veterinary care, pet food or financial assistance to keep animals safe and healthy.

### TEACHING COMPASSION

Taught **3,501** school children **11,972** compassion lessons so they become humanitarians.

### CAT SANCTUARY

Prevented suffering and cruelty for **190** displaced or threatened cats through permanent sanctuary care.
