PET ADOPTIONS

Placed 7,963 animals into homes.

LOST & FOUND

Provided **5,520** hours of casework for families and reunited 920 lost animals.

FOSTER HOMES

Cared for **2,535** most vulnerable animals through volunteer foster homes.

DISASTER RESPONSE

Rescued 852 animals from harm's way through 46 emergency rescue operations. neutering 9,379 dogs and cats.

SHELTER MEDICINE

Provided veterinary care to 8,923 shelter animals through our Sam Greer Clinic.

DISEASE PREVENTION

Administered 24,903 vaccinations preventing deadly diseases like rabies.

COMMUNITY CAT PROGRAM

Prevented thousands of homeless kittens by spaying or neutering 1,581 community cats and returning them to their habitat.

ANIMAL **CRUELTY**

ADVOCACY & INVESTIGATIONS

Provided case support to law enforcement to conduct 337 cruelty investigations.

COMMUNITY MEDICINE

Provided **1,504** dogs and cats in families with veterinary care, pet food or financial assistance to keep animals safe and healthy.

TEACHING COMPASSION

Taught 7,455 school children 22,160 compassion lessons so they become future humanitarians.

CAT SANCTUARY

Prevented suffering and cruelty for **171** displaced or threatened cats through permanent refuge.

NKSC24 Accomplishments

- Created the largest annual statewide dog and cat adoption event in the United States five years in a row.
- Reduced statewide euthanasia by 32,000 dogs and cats from 2016 to 2022.
- On track to achieve the world record for vaccinating / microchipping upwards of 2,000 dog and cats in a single day, February 18, 2023.
