## ENDING UNNECESSARY EUTHANASIA

### PET ADOPTIONS

Found loving families for **6,161** homeless animals, from hamsters to horses, mostly dogs and cats.

### LOST & FOUND

Provided **4,662** hours of research and casework to reunite **777** animals with their loved ones.

### FOSTER HOMES

Cared for **3,784** of the most vulnerable animals through volunteer foster homes so they can lead healthy and thriving lives with families.

### EMERGENCY RESCUE

Rescued **447** animals from harm's way through **38** emergency rescue operations.

## ENDING OVERPOPULATION

### SPAYING / NEUTERING

Spayed or neutered **14,649** animals to prevent the births of countless unwanted litters.

### SHELTER MEDICINE

Alleviated suffering of **12,475** shelter animals in need of veterinary care through the animal hospital.

### DISEASE PREVENTION

Administered **39,112** lifesaving vaccines to prevent the outbreak of deadly diseases such as rabies.

### COMMUNITY CAT PROGRAM

Sterilized, vaccinated, and microchipped **3,340** community cats, followed by the return to their natural habitat to reduce their population and prevent thousands of homeless kittens and free roaming cats, along with preventing the deaths of countless birds.

## ENDING ANIMAL CRUELTY

### ADVOCACY & INVESTIGATIONS

Provided forensics investigation support to law enforcement agencies in **91** cruelty cases.

### COMMUNITY MEDICINE

Provided **1,310** dogs and cats with veterinary care, pet food, and other assistance to help keep them safe and healthy with their families.

### TEACHING COMPASSION

Taught **34,618** compassion lessons to **13,478** students, helping to reduce violence to people and animals while reinforcing humanitarian values.

### BEAR GREER MEMORIAL CAT SANCTUARY

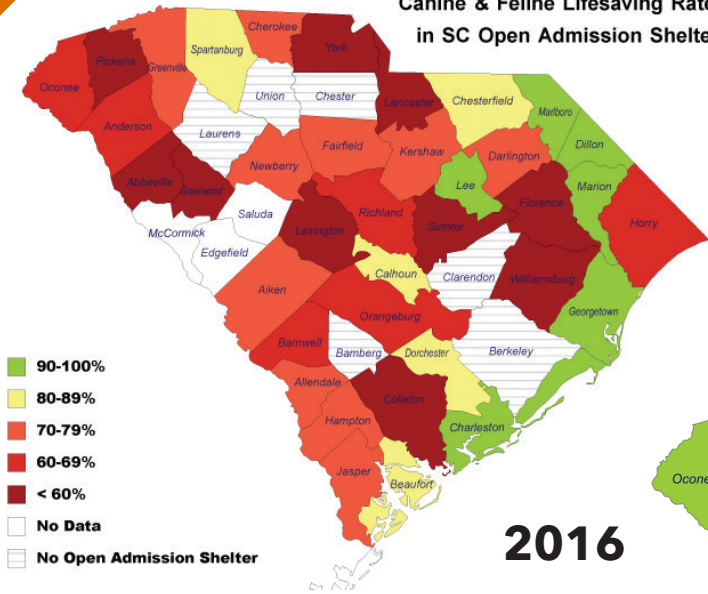
Prevented suffering and cruelty for **141** displaced or threatened outdoor cats through safe refuge.

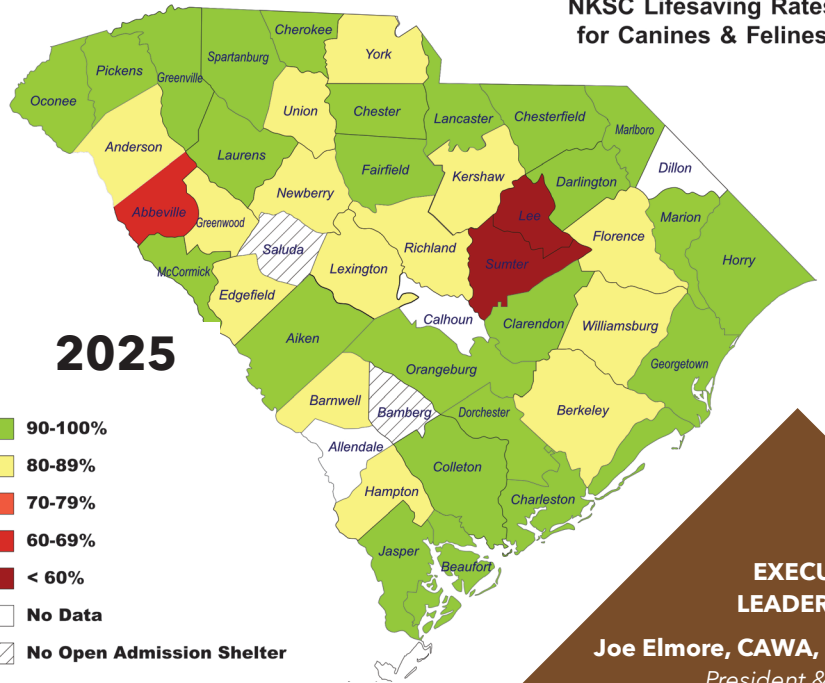
**Canine & Feline Lifesaving Rates

- Since SC achieved No Kill statewide, our focus is shifting to increasing lifesaving in individual communities. Five additional counties achieved No Kill in 2025

- 2,416 dogs and cats adopted
- 334 spay/neuter surgeries in 7 counties helped get pets adoption-ready

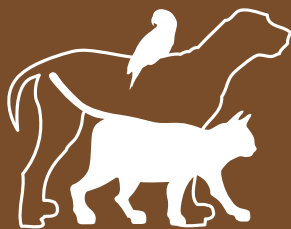
